Christos Anesti!", as we continue with the season of Holy Pascha and the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! Today we pray especially for those who died and those whose lives continue to be impacted by the Nuclear Disaster that occurred 32 years ago on April 26, 1986 at Chernobyl in Ukraine. As we observe this 32nd Anniversary, let us be mindful to continue to pray for our fellow Ukrainians and our ancestral homeland not only because of this anniversary but always that God will guide them and us through all the challenges we all face every day!
